

Terms and Conditions

Any deposit paid over the internet or by telephone is fully refundable if upon viewing of the puppy you decide not to proceed. Upon viewing of the puppy and agreement to continue with the sale your deposit becomes non-refundable and deducted off the sale price.

Your puppy purchase from Little Rascals is guaranteed as a pet only. Whilst all the care and attention has been made to make sure that your puppy has had the absolute best care we do not breed dogs to comply perfectly to breed standard for the purpose of showing or guaranteed to breed in the future.

In the case of a purchase of a pure breed dog a bloodline certificate will be supplied by Little Rascals. Whilst the puppy is in our care all requirements and care will be the responsibility of Little Rascals. Once a puppy has left our premises it is the new owner's full responsibility to maintain the puppy requirements and care including routine vaccination, insurance, flea and worm treatment.

Your puppy has been purchased in good health and all vaccinations and worming are up to date and the next vaccination and worming has been explained. Your puppy will need to be registered with your chosen vet and they will require to see your new puppy. If your veterinary surgeon finds any problem which in his/hers opinion, renders the puppy unfit for sale within 7 days of purchase the purchase price of the puppy will be refunded on condition that the puppy is returned within 7 days of purchase and with a veterinary report.

Should you discover any problems with your puppy after the first 7 days of collection the new owner should contact us immediately and in the first instance. We at Little Rascals will do everything we possibly can to help you as new owners to rectify the problem.

In the event of your new puppy requiring treatment the new owners must contact Little Rascals immediately and prior to any treatment. We may ask for you to return the puppy to us in order to be inspected by our own vet and any care required will be undertaken by ourselves. In the event of distant sales Little Rascals must be contacted in the first instance to gain written authorisation for treatment. If the above term is not followed this may result in the new owners being liable for all costs. Once the new owners vet examine their new puppy as fully fit and well any further medical issues will not be the responsibility of Little Rascals.

Your new puppy is guaranteed from genetic defect. Should a genetic defect be found a full refund will be offered and the puppy may be required to be returned to Little Rascals. In the case of this the owner must contact Little Rascals in the first instance with a full valid vet report, clinical history of the dog and proof of purchase from Little Rascals. However, new owners should not undertake veterinary procedures without prior authority, in writing, from Little Rascals.

Return policy; should a puppy be returned for any other reason than a medical condition accompanied with a full vet report/clinical history, **NO** refund will be given.

In the event that you are no longer able to care for your puppy or family circumstances change, Little Rascals will accept the dog back but no refund will be given. You must contact us in the first instance.

It is the new owner's responsibility to maintain insurance cover for their new puppy at the end of the period of free insurance. Little Rascals are not responsible for any excess charges in the event of a claim.

As the new owner of one of our puppies you are agreeing to be their responsible person and have a duty of care for the puppy under The Animal Welfare Act 2006.
